

Block Party Permit Application Rules and Requirements

In addition to filling out the Special Events Application, the Borough will need the following:

1) Names and addresses, block and lots and signatures of all the neighbors participating or affected by the partial street closure for a block party. Their signature indicates consent to the proposed block party, street closure and acknowledgement that all residents and their guests shall adhere to all applicable laws, regulations and ordinances, including, but not limited to noise ordinances.

Rules:

- 1) Conduct of the block party will not result in damage to persons or property nor cause serious harm to the public.
- 2) No more than <u>one (1)</u> block party permit for the same street may be issued in <u>one calendar year</u>.
- 3) No block party permit shall be issued if a block party permit has been previously issued for the same street which is the subject of the currently proposed block party, and said previously issued permit was revoked by the Borough due to violations of this chapter or any applicable ordinances, laws or regulations within the previous five (5) calendar years.
- 4) Block parties shall be authorized only upon Borough-owned streets, and shall not be authorized upon any street which is owned and under the jurisdiction of Ocean County or the State of New Jersey.
- 5) No block party shall last nor continue for more than four (4) hours.
- 6) No block party shall be conducted in such manner as to interfere with the safe passage of emergency vehicles.
