As you may be aware we are in need of new Board Workers. The Ocean County Board of Elections is reaching out to you for assistance in our ongoing recruitment drive. A trustworthy electoral process requires hard working and principled Board Workers.

New Board Workers are often referred to our office by our Municipal Clerks and we hope that you know of office staff, friends, or family who would like to sign up. **We are also asking you to add the link below to your website, e-mail lists or newsletters and post the link to the application on any social media you may use as well as any Television Stations you may run.**

The compensation for Board Workers has been raised for the **Primary and General Elections to \$300 for each day**. In addition, many Board Workers earn an extra \$12.50 for picking up the election supply bag from the municipal building and an additional \$12.50 for returning the election supply bag from the polling place back to the municipal building on election night, after the polls have closed.


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LETTER FROM THE COMMISSIONERS

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS***What Training is Needed?***

A 3 hour Hands-On Training must be attended prior to working the polls. By law, Board Workers must also attend a Recertification Class every 2 years. Additional classes may be held for any new laws or changes in Election procedures.

When Am I Needed and Where Will I Work?

Board Workers are needed for every Election held during the year. You may be placed in a district where a vacancy exists or where additional help is needed. Every attempt is made to place Board Workers in or close to the town where they reside.

What Do I Have To Do?

- Pick Up Red Supply Bag
- Report at 5:15AM on Election Day
- Prepare the room for voting, including the set-up of voting equipment and supplies
- Open the polls, Process voters throughout the day, Close the Polls
- Return the Red Supply Bag
