Beach Haven Parks & Recreation Survey Results

October 17, 2023 Beach Haven Parks & Recreation Committee

Introduction

- The survey's objective was to obtain community input on the usage of Beach Haven (BH) parks, favorite activities, areas of improvement, and support for initiatives. The results of the survey are intended to advise the Beach Haven Council on investments, and to guide Parks and Recreation Committee priorities.
- We received a strong and credible survey response from a diverse community of **1,946 respondents** including residents and visitors, of which **1,252 or 63% were from Beach Haven**. This survey received 1300% more responses than a prior similar survey about Beach Haven parks conducted in 2011.
- The community's engagement was high, with over 62% of respondents writing comments and suggestions
- The survey was widely disseminated, open for 6 weeks, and gathered both online and paper responses.

Executive Summary

- Beach Haven's 11 acres of dedicated parks plus miles of beach and bay are widely-used and highly appreciated features of our town
- Improving ease of access to our beaches was the highest supported priority (81% support), and the beach was the most used recreational area (94%) among Beach Haven respondents
- Increasing shade and trees (74% support) to increase enjoyment and health/safety, while also improving flood resilience, was also highly supported by Beach Haven respondents
- Dedicated bicycle lanes are heavily used (75%) and most indicate biking (78%) and walking/running (80%) as their top activity
- 51% support; 27% do not support a splash park / fountain (BH respondents)
- 48% do not support; 35% support additional pickleball courts (BH respondents)
- 50% do not support; 34% support a new skate park (BH respondents)
- Need for improved maintenance of existing park areas (115 comments) and greater utilization and increased programming in our wonderful park areas (108 comments)
- Requests for movie night (484 comments) and sports tournaments (189 comments) among many other events and activities.









We got strong representation from all age groups. Parents and grandparents commented that their children and grandchildren use and love our parks.




Which parks & recreational areas do you enjoy?

Shade and trees provide a place to cool off, sit and relax in our parks without the direct heat of the sun. Playground goers requested shade since metal equipment gets too hot and also shaded benches. Many respondents requested planting large shade trees and native plants. Trees also help improve flood resilience.

What Improvements would you like to see? (1218 responses)

1. Better maintenance of various parks settings: need for more garbage cans, more doggy bags, repair and the addition of playground equipment, basketball courts, playing fields etc. (115 comments)

2. Greater utilization of the existing parks, Walsh Field, Veterans Park and the grass field at Bay Village: Ex: add picnic tables and benches, more activities for children, new playground and equipment, bocce courts, volleyball courts, more bike racks, parking etc. (108)

3. Preserve existing and add more green spaces (83)

4. Fence in the dog beach, add shade and benches, and a rinse off station. Consider a dog park, and allowing dogs on the beach (66)

5. Allow beach cabanas (43)

6. Address bike and pedestrian safety (40)

What Improvements would you like to see? (1218 responses)

- 7. Provide greater teenage crowd control (36)
- 8. More water fountains to fill bottles (25)
- 9. Recognize and benefit Beach Haven homeowners with lower fees, a single badge for all activities and preferential court times (22)
- 10. Provide more bay access for paddle boarders and kayakers with floating docks and ladders. (20)

The following items were also mentioned: More bathrooms open longer (19); create a bay beach (15); More bathrooms, showers and rinse off stations (9); Public pool (5); More fishing and crabbing locations on the Bay, and more surf fishing beaches (5);Permanent fencing; full or partial around Veterans park (4); Fence at children's park on Taylor Ave. (4); Life Guards after 5 PM (2); Relocate siren at Nelson (3); Fire pits on the beach (3); Paddle courts (2); ice skating rink (2); Exercise station and walking trail (2); park setting at the old Coast Guard station(2). There are 13 miscellaneous comments listed once each.

What new programs & events would you like to attend?

996 Responses:

- 1. Movie nights (484 comments)
- 2. Sports tournaments and leagues (189)
- 3. Concerts in the Park (122). Some respondents asked for varying nights, not just during the week or summer.
- Programs for children of all ages- camps, youth sports activities/leagues, toddler (under age 5) activities, pre-teen activities, teen activities (34 largest expressed need). Respondents also expressed interest in family focused programming (17)
- 5. Dance programs (76)
- 6. Skateboarding activities and competitions (61)

7. Exercise classes/Yoga (32) respondents expressed interest, some respondents wanted lower cost classes
